"Nightmare" Repairs in Iconic Neighborhood

The Paa-Ko repair nightmare continues! This small hole (photo right) in this air-vac line caused 12 hours

of outages to homes on Raindance Road and the loss of 250,000 gallons of water. Why? Because the contractor used galvanized pipe, which corrodes quickly in our hard water. So why did such a small leak become a huge problem? Because when Paako was developed 27 years ago, it was common practice to dig a common trench for



all utilities, except for sewer. This design feature resulted in and significantly increased repair times as Entranosa's crew needed to determine the locations of the gas line (outlined in black, photo left) and the power line (outlined in white). Finally, Entranosa repaired the leak with a wrap-around. To make repairs more efficient, Entranosa endeavors never to share the same trench with other utilities.

Valley Well Inches Closer to Completion



With some final adjustments from Rogers and Company, the Valley Irrigation well is alive and inching closer to coming on-line. The new well is one of the larger-producing wells in the system, which had taken almost two years to permit and

develop. Entranosa's next step is to complete a 6,600 -foot transmission line to connect this new well into the full system. Entranosa anticipates fully utilizing the Valley Well for drinking water by early September.

and operator Tristan Encinias are completing their first weld of HDPE pipe. Recently, they received their pipe welding certificates. Pipe welding had always been subcontracted out, which caused delays and increased costs. Entranosa had stopped doing road cuts due to the challenges of permitting, the



high costs of asphalt and ongoing maintenance. The alternative is boring underneath the road and pulling HDPE pipe through the bore.
