Getting a Boost


Entranosa's crews install new booster pumps at the Frost Midline Booster station. The boosters will increase pumping capacity from 800 gallons-per-minute (gpm) to 1,100 gpm during the peak season.



New Booster Station

At the intersection of Frost and Vallecitos Roads, a new

booster station has been installed. The booster will improve flow and pressures for members at Vallecitos Estates, Richland Ridge and Richland Meadow, along with reducing the demand on the Woodlands Tank.


