Measure Your Pressure!

Valve or a PRV, and this is an excellent example of a design that measures incoming and outgoing pressures and gives the homeowner the ability to adjust the pressures using the PRV. If members cannot afford to install a home PRV, the next best solution is to use a pressure gauge and test pressures at the hose bibb. If pressures exceed 80 psi, the homeowner needs to call Entranosa immediately.

Update: Septic Closeout Entranosa staff has calculated 90% of the 2,436 septic accounts with

following results:

- 2,436 total accounts
- 2,209 account summaries completed
- 227 accounts remaining
- Water bill credits totaling \$96,685.
- Refunds \$41,156.
- Final pumping \$30,000
- Total credits, refunds and pumping \$167,841. Average credit \$76.
- 298 accounts were not eligible due to violations of contracts and Bylaws
