Continuing Education—Safe Ditches

Entranosa's talented field crew

is training on a new type of safer and money-saving ditch shoring equipment. The Smartshore equipment is new technology that allows ditch protection without the heavy steel devices that require earth-moving equipment for placement. The new technology is OSHA approved, inflatable on site, and can be lifted and installed by two operators in less than 15 minutes.



Welcome S4!

This is the start of Entranosa's newest well,

dubbed \$4.

Operators Tristan Encinias and Eli Chavez (welding) are extending the well casing to protect the well during construction of the sanitary seal. S4 well is 512 feet deep, tested at 600 gallons per minute (gpm) and has an expected life of over 100 years. The well and transmission line will take approximately one year, so the new well should be online 2026.
