The New Mexico Office of the State Engineer recently approved the use of East Pine Canyon well. Entranosa's crews are working on the transmission line from the well to a main transmission line along Highway 472. The new well will produce 375 gallons per minute and will provide a needed addition to the central valley wells.

Problems in Paa-Ko Communities



Crews finished a problem area off Tewa Court in Paa-Ko Communities. In the past several years there have been over five leaks because the original contractors bedded the pipe in rock, which gradually wears holes in pipe surfaces. The line had to be relocated because the

adjacent property owner had landscaped and paved over the line's air-vac. Please don't landscape the right-of-way because in this situation the extra work cost Entranosa more than \$10,000.
